
JK2888 Egyptian

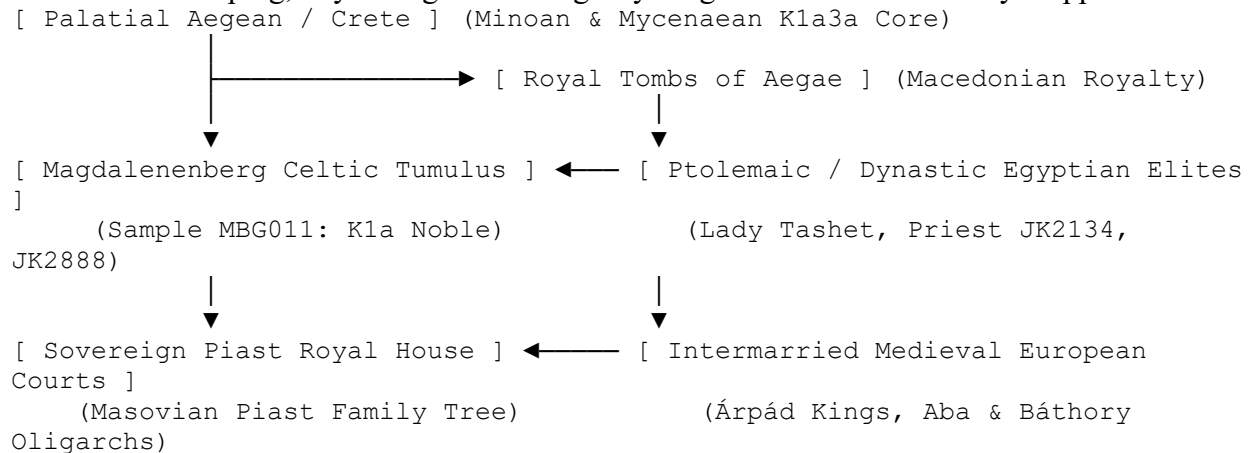
